#### **MECHANICAL SUPERINTENDENT – ENG04 x1**

Role Purpose: Mechanical Superintendent reporting directly to the Engineering Manager is responsible for the safe operation and maintenance of all mechanical machinery and equipment on Tschudi mining site. The Mechanical Superintendent must ensure sustained engineering availability on relevant equipment by maintaining a high standard of best maintenance practices. The incumbent will also provide consulting/advice/mechanical services for all mechanical engineering-related operations at Tschudi Mine, as well as design and installation of new infrastructure for expansion projects.

#### **Key Performance areas:**

- Provide focused leadership and supervision for the mechanical section, ensuring effective planning, execution, and reporting of maintenance and repair activities across mechanical equipment and facilities.
- Build, guide, and mentor a team of artisans, supervisors, engineers and contractors, ensuring competency development and discipline in delivering reliable and safe maintenance services.
- Implement and manage mechanical maintenance strategies, schedules, procedures, and resource plans to meet availability and reliability targets for Tschudi fixed and mobile equipment and infrastructure.
- Ensure strict compliance with statutory requirements, mine health and safety regulations, and internal standards during all mechanical operations.
- Identify and drive continuous improvements in mechanical maintenance systems, procedures, and execution practices to enhance equipment performance and extend asset life.
- Coordinate with suppliers, contractors, and OEMs to ensure timely availability of spares, technical support, and cost-effective solutions to mechanical problems.
- Review and recommend mechanical design adjustments or modifications to improve safety, reduce downtime, and increase efficiency of plant operations.

#### **Requirements and Experience:**

- Bachelor's Degree in Mechanical Engineering from a recognised institution.
- Master's Degree in Mechanical or Industrial Engineering is highly desirable and will be considered an additional advantage.
- Minimum of 5 years' relevant experience in a mining or processing plant environment, with at least 2 years in a supervisory role.
