Tshwane University of Technology is pleased to announce the implementation of DHET's the 'New Generation of Academics' Programme (nGAP).

INSTRUCTIONS: Applicants are required to submit, together with the CVs, a fully completed standardized application form available from the university intranet as well as recently certified copies of qualifications and Identity Document. Failure to comply with this instruction will disqualify the candidate. Candidates may be subjected to appropriate psychometric testing and other selection instruments.

The nGAP aims to assist with staffing transformation and capacity needs at TUT, and will result in the establishment of a permanent academic post. The successful candidate will participate in a 6-year comprehensive development and induction programme, after which she/he will continue as a regular member of the academic staff at TUT.

To be eligible for selection for an nGAP post, applicants must meet the following criteria, specified by the university:

- Show interest in becoming an academic
- Obtained at least 70% average marks for Masters's degree (**attach academic record/transcript**)
- Be 40 years or younger
- Show evidence of eligibility to undertake postgraduate study at Doctoral level
- Be willing to commit to placement at the appointing university for the full 6 years of the programme

At least 80% of the position will be allocated to Blacks (African, Coloured and Indian men and women including people with disabilities) *men and women including people with disabilities*, of which at least 55% of the positions should be taken up by Black women.

Minimum requirements for the following fields

- A relevant Masters/MTech degree in the following field:
